## What areas should you clean if your supervisor or colleagues are sick or in self-isolation?

- If no cover staff have been arranged, those cleaning operatives turning up to site must prioritise tasks, as previously planned and agreed with your Supervisor and/or Manager.
- Focus on cleaning the following areas (high risk infection areas):
  - Emptying bins
  - Toilets
  - Kitchen
  - Reception
  - Touch Points

### High Risk Infection Areas

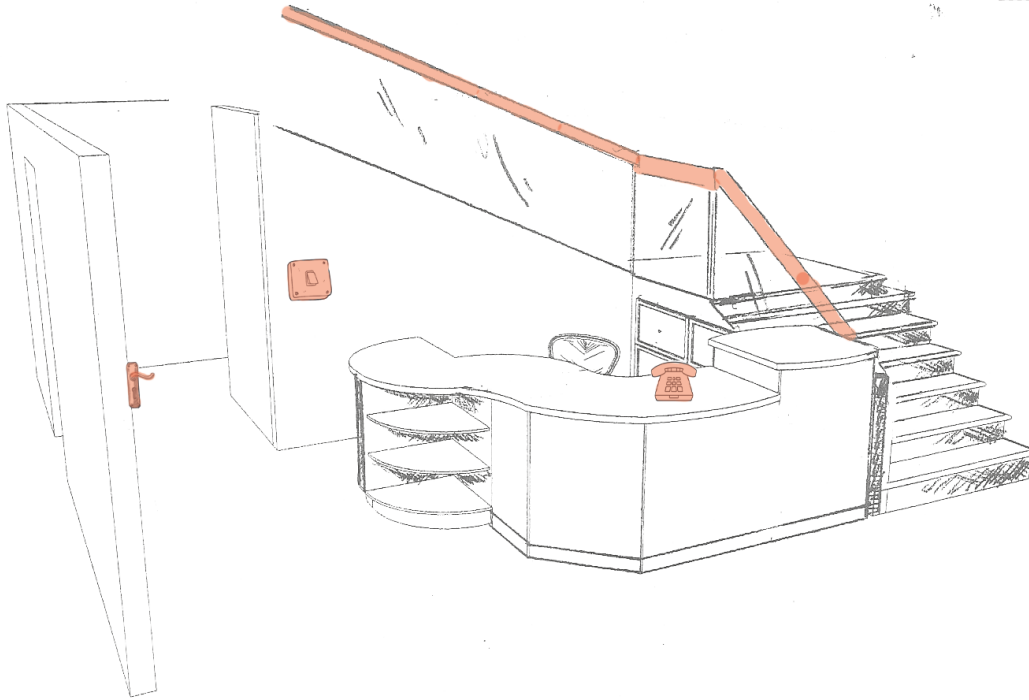
These need to be cleaned on a regular basis to create protection against pathogen spread.

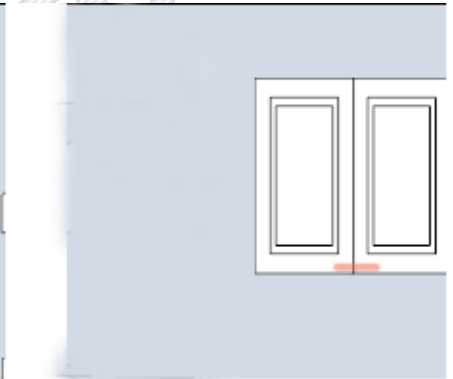
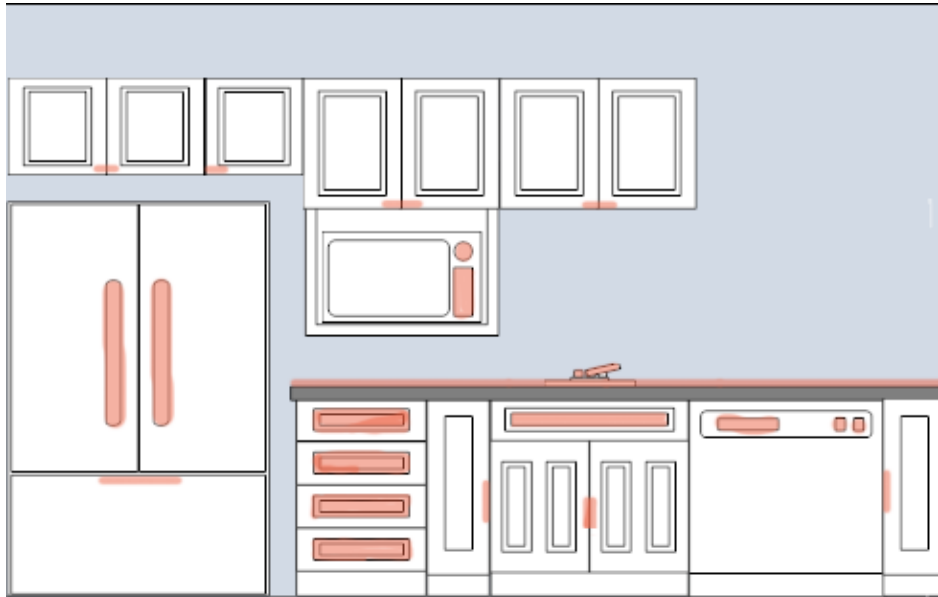
